### **Eligibility for Scholarships:**

To be eligible for consideration for the scholarships listed above the student must meet the criteria listed below.

1. Must meet requirements of show as stated in Rule #1 under Competition and must be a graduating senior.
2. Must have shown or will show at the PCLIA Livestock show at least one year.
3. Must meet all the requirements of the PCLIA as listed in the rulebook.
4. Must submit application, three letters of reference, and an official high school transcript on or before May 1, 2016 This should be mailed to:

5. All applicants will be required to give a personal interview before the scholarship committee. Dates and times will be announced prior to the date.
6. The selection for all scholarships listed in the catalog will be based upon PCLIA criteria unless different criteria are established by the donor.
7. Exhibitor must be a current and active member of a Parker County 4H or FFA chapter or Azle ISD.
8. SCHOLARSHIPS WILL EXPIRE ONE (1) YEAR (12 MONTHS) FROM DATE OF THE SHOW.
9. A minimum of 10 hours of documented volunteer time with the PCLIA is required for any scholarship applicant from the class of 2018 and beyond. Scholarship applicants from the class of 2017 applicants must have 5 hours of documented PCLIA volunteer hours for eligibility. Volunteer hours will be documented and approved by contacting PCLIA Secretary Annette Sledge by phone at 806-543-6661 or by email at [pcliainfo@gmail.com](mailto:pcliainfo@gmail.com) and logged into a spreadsheet. An email will be sent to the applicant and scholarship committee confirming volunteer hours on or before 3 weeks prior to due date. A copy of the email must accompany the scholarship application. Examples of PCLIA volunteer hours include working at tag-in, cleaning show grounds, working with fundraising activities (Gala or Golf Tournament) or working at the stock show or sale.
